- Tournament Format:** State Championships will have D1 & D2 Championships based on entries.
Pool Play to tournament play with 3 game guarantees.
- AAU Registration:** Club Teams must have AAU membership. Each athlete & coach must have an AAU membership to participate. If not, contact the District Registrar or register online at www.aausports.org.
- Entry Deadline:** Must use attached form and return by April 16. Late entries are accepted until April 23 with \$50 late fee. Please contact Sport Director Andy Fishman if you plan to submit a late entry at 513-477-0991 or Ohio Governor, Ken Yablonsky, ken_yab@yahoo.com. - Entry Fee:** \$300 payable to Ohio AAU. Mail completed entry forms, rosters and birth certificates to: Ohio AAU Girls Basketball c/o Ken Yablonsky 5763 Rutledge Trail Hamilton, OH 45011
- Rosters:** Must be mailed with entry. Changes to roster may be made up until 30 minutes before playing first tournament game. See AAU handbook regarding locked rosters (if qualified for Nationals through an SRT before participating in DQT).
- Age Determination:** See age calculator on www.aausports.org (under girls' basketball).
- Birth Record:** Photocopies should be sent with tournament entry form. These must be turned in at least 30 minutes prior to the first game is played.
- Grade Exemption:** Form needed for those athletes who do not meet age qualification, but meet grade qualification.
- Coach Responsibility:** Coaches are responsible for all standard rules of play, equipment. Team must have both White and Dark uniform. All coaches will adhere to dress code (collared shirt, no cut offs or open toe shoes) and behavior sportsmanship ethics code.

- Forfeiture:** Teams who do not show up for a tournament game will lose their registration and entry fees.

The remaining teams advance to DII Nationals unless team has qualified via SRT to DI National Championship

DIVISION II DISTRICT QUALIFYING TOURNAMENT ... Ohio State Championship

District Finish	National Championship
1st place & 2nd place	Division II
3rd place & 4th place	Division II or Division III (team's choice) ...

The remaining teams advance to DII or DIII Nationals (Team's Choice)
